

Self-isolation guide for Agricultural Employees

Agribusiness **employer** Have any of your employees YES travelled from overseas or from a metropolitan area? NO Have they travelled from regional areas? OR They are local to your business?

If your employee has been outside Australia in the last 14 days

If your employee is coming from a metropolitan area in any state

If your employee is coming from a Covid-19 hotspot

OR

They must self-quarantine in a nominated place (e.g. hotel) for 14 days, then complete the <u>declaration form</u> and carry it with them

They must self-quarantine in a nominated place (e.g. hotel) for 14 days or take a Covid-19 test receiving a negative result. They should complete the <u>declaration form</u> prior to commencing work. It is highly recommended you ask to see this declaration form and register seeing it (via a photo). Ensure there is a visa number on the form.

The employees can travel directly to a place of secured employment. They must be able to provide a record of their previous work and residence in the last 14 days, including proof of self-quarantining if relevant by completing the declaration form. It is highly recommended you ask to see this <u>declaration form</u> and register seeing it (via a photo). Ensure there is a visa number on the form.

The employees can travel directly to a place of secured employment.

Your workplace must comply with public health directions and social distancing requirements.
