Agribusiness **employees**

Are you employed in agriculture or commercial fishing industries?

Which scenario best suits you? Follow its path

You have been outside Australia in the last 14 days

You must self-quarantine in a nominated place (e.g. hotel) for 14 days. Then complete the declaration form and carry it with you.

You are coming from a metropolitan area in any state

You must self-quarantine in a nominated place (e.g. hotel) for 14 days. Then complete the declaration form and carry it with you.

You are coming from a regional area in another state

If coming from a regional area, head straight to your secured employment with a completed declaration form.

You are already in regional NSW and moving to a new employer

Head straight to your secured employment. You must be able to provide a record of your previous work and residence in the last 14 days (including proof of self-quarantining if relevant). Complete the declaration form.



You must comply with public health directions and social distancing requirements, and report if you are feeling unwell.
