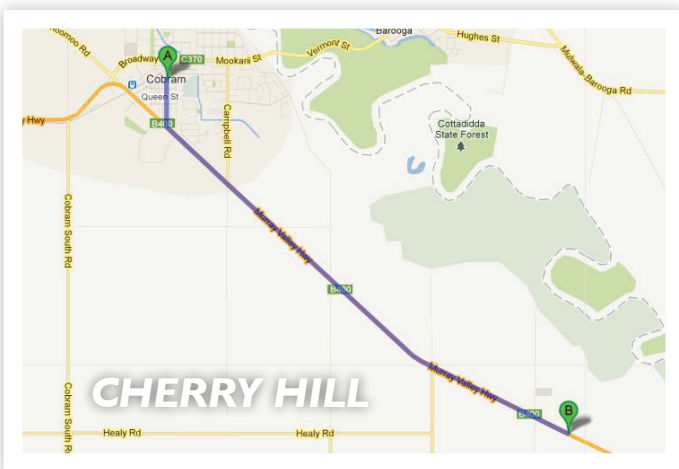
Directions to Visiting Orchards

From Cobram to Cherry Hill, 2737 Murray Valley Highway, Cobram East

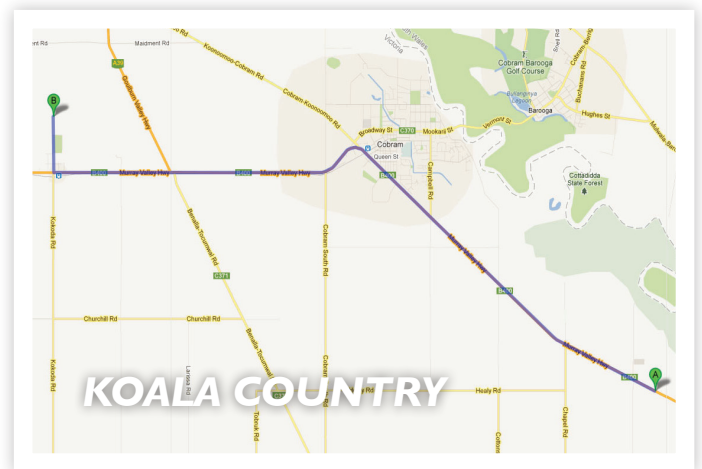
1. Head **south** on **High St** toward **Bank St**..... 0.8 km
2. Turn **left** onto **Murray Valley Hwy/B400**..... 8.0 km
8.8 km - about 8 mins

From Cherry Hill to Koala Country, Kenny Road, Yarraweyah

1. Head **northwest** on **Murray Valley Hwy/B400** toward **Healy Rd**..... 16.6 km
2. Turn **right** onto **Kenny Rd**..... 1.3 km
17.9 km - about 17 mins
